## Search email and data

Electronically stored information (ESI) is subject to the similar chain of evidence requirements as hard copies. Investigators and attorneys must efficiently and quickly view evidence that lies within email. Human resources managers must investigate suspicious email activity by searching the entire pool of available information, find what they need and easily export the documents for action.

## Analyze patterns within the evidence

Intella excels at Early Case Assessment within the common model of eDiscovery during the processing, review and analysis phases.

Often attorneys and eDiscovery professionals rely on the Electronic Discovery Reference Model (EDRM) to breakdown the phases and requirements for working effectively with ESI. Processing involves reducing the volume of ESI and when necessary, converting it to forms more suitable for review and analysis. During the review phase, the ESI is evaluated for relevance and privilege. Key patterns, topics, people and discussions are discovered in the analysis phase by evaluating the content and context of the ESI.

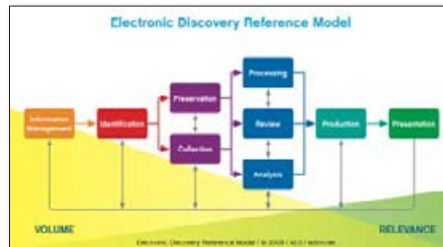

Intella allows you to conduct your own Early Case Assessment and quickly process, review and analyze ESI, especially the email and data files most commonly encountered. Intella first examines the files and then creates a reverse index of the email or data files without altering the data.

This reverse indexing process delves deep into the files examining both the body and the metadata of the email, any attachments or data within files. Each email, document, attachment or embedded document is tracked individually. The user is able to search or export the index created by Intella. This index is a very useful tool for analysts who need to examine encrypted or password protected files.

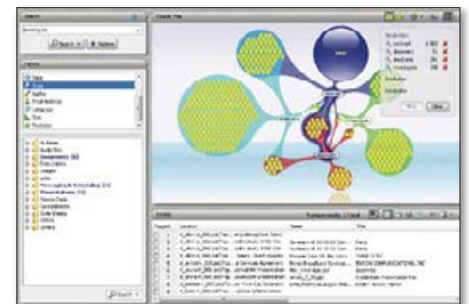
Intella assists your initial review by quickly displaying and filtering your searches. It:

- Examines each email and file;
- Examines any embedded or attached document;
- Identifies images, encrypted files and Optical Character Recognition (OCR) candidates for further processing quickly; and
- Displays and tracks the relationship between each parent document and its descended documents.

An investigator or attorney can search the facets of the document or message for a variety of search terms and wild cards. Complex searches can be quickly created and altered by including and excluding search terms. Searches are visually displayed using a wide variety of user-selected views including a list, thumbnails, a relationship timeline and the most exciting option – the Cluster Map.

Intella's Cluster Map is a unique visualization tool which assists you in analyzing the patterns and relationships in the data. A novice or experienced analyst, investigator or attorney can see relevant patterns within the large complex data sets or email files.

Analysts may also view results in tables, lists, time-lines and thumbnails and export the reports and images into a variety of formats. Documents that are of interest, have privileges or are of other importance can be tagged or flagged for further search, evaluation or review. The combination of rapid searches and visual analysis increases the speed that your team finds and acts on relevant information.
